Where: West End Building, 4101 Kruse Way, Lake Oswego

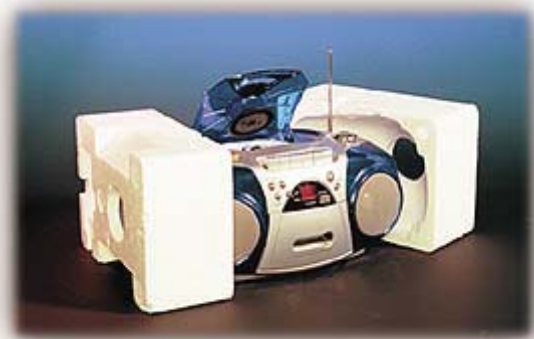
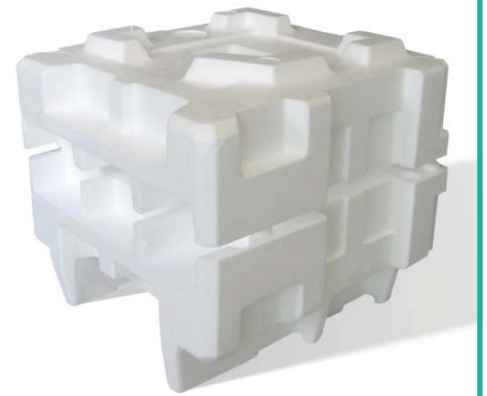
Bring your block foam to this one-day collection and recycling event. By recycling your foam, you can be part of the solution. Recycling is one of the easiest ways you can help reduce waste and slow climate change. By recycling at home, work, or school, you help significantly lower carbon emissions associated with extracting virgin materials, manufacturing products, and waste disposal.

Volunteers will be on hand to collect clean, dry, and bagged block foam.

Accepted types of block foam packaging material include:

- **Expanded Polystyrene, EPS Styrofoam®** – This foam snaps when you break it and is used as packing material. Colored materials are okay. (EPS #6 recycling symbol)

Please, **NO** foam peanuts or packing pellets.



Cost: \$5 per car load or \$10 per pick-up truck/van/SUV load to cover the cost of transport and recycling. Please coordinate with your neighbors, if possible, to reduce the number of vehicles heading to the event.
